

During the ceremony, I will be alternating between French, Swiss-German, and English. For those of you who don't understand one of these languages, please refer to the translation provided on arrival.



PART II: SERIOUS MOMENTS



Huh, that really wakes you up, doesn't it?

Just like the many fun and exciting "firsts," another important part of a relationship are the more serious moments. The things you learn from and with each other, and the difficulties that end up making you realize how serious you actually are about each other.

One such moment for Tobias and Loris was another first: Their first of many conversations about sex, intimacy and vulnerability. It was an honest exchange that Tobias remembers as being surprising, scary, yet also incredibly validating. This kind of open honesty would become a constant in their relationship, which- I mean that's just exactly how it should be, isn't it?

Inevitably when you are with someone for a while, you will experience devastating events together as well. The loss of Loris' grandfather Gabriel and also his grand-mother Anne-Marie were two such events. Both times, Loris was able to count on Tobias' support- he describes Tobias as his rock, always there if he needed him, yet still confident in Loris's own resilience. For Loris, that presence was very reassuring and comforting.

Tobias on the other hand was deeply impressed by how Loris handled the passing of two loved-ones. At both his grandfather's and also his grandmother's funeral, Loris gave a touching eulogy, sad yet beautiful. He didn't hide his grief, he gave it room and the appropriate gravity, let his family relive memories they shared with the deceased and therefore became a touchstone for everyone in that difficult moment. Not for the first time, Tobias saw why Loris's family and friends loved him so in moments like this.



His eloquence, his emotional maturity and human presence strengthening and reassuring everyone around him.

We all know Tobias is a gentle person- but did you know he has a fiery side, too?

How many of you have a memory of Loris getting angry? Yeah, we all know he is a passionate person who makes his thoughts known. However, one core memory for both Loris and Tobias is a moment where Tobias was the one who exploded in furious rage. The details don't matter, but for Tobias, it was an important learning experience about what it means to show strength. In the conversation that followed Tobias's very uncharacteristic outburst, he found out that he doesn't need to raise his voice for Loris to hear him. On the contrary, Loris appreciates that Tobias's strength doesn't show through loud words but in his calm kindness. I admire them both for teaching each other in such uncomplicated, non-judgmental ways, it's truly inspiring.

Loris greatly enjoys being around people- so much so, that he sometimes forgets to eat while drinking and having a good time. Of course, that often ends with him getting accidentally drunk. In those moments, Tobias happily takes care of him while Loris makes strange requests- for example, he asks Tobias for "pañuelos" – handkerchiefs in Spanish- or sugar. Yeah, I don't get it either, but that's not the point, is it? Loris describes Tobias as his "hero" when thinking of those moments- even if Tobias sometimes does nothing more than bring him a pañuelo- whereas Tobias just loves that he gets to take care of the man he loves. Isn't that just wonderful?

In everyday life, Tobias is great at showing Loris his love in relation to food. He surprises Loris with Emmi Café Latte and pain au chocolat, or welcomes him home after a hard day dealing with the world's misery with a home-cooked meal and a Bloody Mary on a really hard day. Sometimes, the purest form of love shows in the little things- yet to Loris, those small attentions are big acts of love he appreciates every single day.



In general, unwavering support is a comforting constant both Tobias and Loris have always freely given to and greatly appreciated about each other. 

One particularly endearing instance was the roadtrip in a camping car they took across Loris's beloved Finland. On that trip, Loris got to witness Tobias fall in love with Finland, too. Sharing his passion with him and seeing Tobias get excited about it as well is an experience Loris greatly cherishes.

On a road trip from the US to Canada, it's kind of a given that one listens to car radio. However, on their way through Maine, Tobias and Loris's musical choices were as monotone as the dry, barren landscape around them: All they were hearing was Christian country rock- and you know how they feel about religion. Which is why when they finally crossed over to Canada, their relief upon finally seeing trees and mountains in winter-wonderland Canada was made palpable by a song they could sing along with.

I can totally see Tobias and Loris listening to that song in the car, feeling every note while the changing landscape welcomed them to Canada, can't you?


However, sugary pop is not the kind of music our grooms listen to most of the time...

It's a side of Loris only few people know, and Tobias loves the humor Loris displays while half-awake. Whether it be using a little boy voice to say "I like soup" or rolling himself up in the blankets and declaring "I am a Burrito-" Loris always makes Tobias laugh and fall in love with him even more in those lazy morning hours.

Loris remembers that back at his old place in Riaz, Tobias often had to chase the family's cat Mimi from their bed. 


I will now pass the mic over to the happy grooms. Because of course those two eloquent secret romantics have prepared some more beautiful words for each other on this day.






A potentiality is not a reality, but it can become one. And that is what our love has become.

We will have had our place together. We will have existed. Together. And this cannot be undone.


My incredibly humble vow today is to be here with you, and to love you, and to do so irreversibly.

Dear son, your mother and I are very happy to know you at the side of this wonderful man. We are sure that you will find security and safety with him.


We have faith in both of you and you will certainly know what to do even without our advice.

My dear son, I am so proud of the man you have become, I admire you and wish you and your beloved husband Tobias a wonderful life. You have fought for it and you deserve the best.


Tobias, my dear son-in-law, I could not dream of a better match for my son, your sweetness, your affection and your love for him fill me with happiness.



For my moments of incomprehension and doubt towards you, I ask your forgiveness.






(ANA) We don't have the words to say how happy we are that we're all getting married today, sorry YOU'RE getting married today.
